PATIENT GUIDE TEAMS VIRTUAL VISIT

Your health professional invites you to a virtual visit using Microsoft Teams. Here are some tips on how to make this virtual visit a positive experience.

You do not need to create an account to use Teams.

STEP 1 – Before the virtual visit

In order to attend a virtual visit, you will need :



Access to high speed Internet



Ability to use technology (or someone to assist you)

For a better experience:



Use a headset.



Email address



One of the following device: tablet, smartphone or computer with camera, speaker and microphone.



Download the Teams app on the device you will use for your virtual appointment. If you are using a computer, the app is

optional*. If you are using a mobile device, the app is available on Google Play or the App Store.

1. In the email you received, check the date and time of the virtual visit and confirm if you will be attending.

2. Test the link Join the Microsoft Teams Meeting to make sure everything is all set for your virtual visit.



STEP 2 – Join the virtual visit

1. A few minutes before your virtual visit, open your invitation email or the event in your calendar and click on the link to Join the Microsoft Teams Meeting.




Note : Depending on your computer or mobile device settings, a pop-up window may appear asking for permission to access your microphone and camera.

- 4. You're now in the meeting room or lobby. You may encounter one of the following scenarios:
 - The health professional is already waiting for you in the meeting room. In this case, the virtual visit will start immediately.
 - You joined the meeting first and must wait for the health professional to join the meeting.
 - You entered the virtual lobby where you must wait until the health professional admits you. If no one admits you to the meeting within 30 minutes, you will be removed from the lobby. If that happens, you can try joining again using the same link.
